Betenson Avenue, Cavendish Avenue, Hill Crest, Robyns Way (north of Lake View Road) and Lambarde Road (north of Hillcrest): Re: comments from residents, the proposals for single yellow line restrictions in these roads are to be approved as part of the Road Traffic Order but not implemented until a definite need is identified following monitoring and review, implementation to be authorised by the Portfolio Holder in consultation with the Residents' Association. Vine Avenue: Remove proposed pay and display from parking areas at the south end (just in from junction with St. Botolphs Road) and replace with 2 hour limited parking or permit parking (for residents and town commuters), i.e. remove pay and display from parking areas at the south end (just in from junction with St. Botolphs Road) and replace with 2 hour limited parking or permit parking (for residents and rail

Woodside Road	 Comments / objections noted, proposals agreed subject to the following comments and amendments: Amend single yellow line restrictions to apply Monday to Friday not Monday to Saturday. Reduce proposed parking bay opposite No. 4 by two spaces (Hitchen Hatch Lane end) to facilitate access.
Charges	 Commuter permits to more closely match cost of car park season tickets; increase from £510 / £625 to £610 / £725 (compared to current season ticket charges) and, in addition, apply any percentage increase considered and approved for season tickets in the Bradbourne and Sennocke car parks. Morewood Close – pay and display day charge to be set at £4. St. Botolphs Area – pay and display day charge to be set at £4. Vine Avenue – commuter permits to be set at same level as other areas.
General	All requests for the provision or removal of yellow lines across driveways will be accommodated.
