Executive Summary: This report describes the progress to date and anticipated progress over the next three months of all programmed highway improvements.

This report supports the Key Aim of Reducing speed, encouraging safer driving and tackling known speeding crash hotspots. Also improving pedestrian safety, including measures to improve access for people with disabilities as indicated in the Sevenoaks Community Plan.

Background

1. The progress of all the proposed **highway improvement schemes** for 2008/9 in the Sevenoaks district are detailed in Appendix A. Details of the progress on the carryover schemes from 2007/8 are also listed.

Discussion

- With the following exceptions, schemes have generally progressed as per programme.
- The planned modifications to the eastbound (Bradbourne Vale Road) approach to the **Bat & Ball crossroads** have had to be postponed until summer 2009 due to conflict with the imminent replacement of a gas main. Because this utility company's works will affect the A25 until July 2009, the modifications to the junction will not now take place until after that date.

The completion of the footway in **Hildenborough Road**, **Leigh** has been suspended due to KCC's inability to agree terms with the owner of the land on which the path was to have been built. Whilst the file has not been closed and negotiations with the land owner will continue, the terms that the land-owner has sought as part of the sale/dedication are far from being acceptable to KCC. There are insufficient grounds for seeking a compulsory purchase order.
