**Recommendation:** It be resolved that Members note receipt of the petition, requesting various highway improvement measures.

## **Background**

- A petition was received from the local Parish Council in Sundridge who are concerned about the danger caused to pedestrians by fast moving traffic in the village.
- A KHS Officer met with the Parish on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2009 to discuss the issues and it was agreed to further investigate matters so that further advice could be offered to a future meeting of the Board.

## Introduction

- In accordance with protocols required on the receipt of petitions, the Board was informed that a petition had been received from local Parish council. The petition, which had 415 signatures.
- The petition concerned the alleged excessive speed of traffic passing through the village. It calls for numerous measures;
  - (a) Safety Cameras at the gateways either end of the village
  - (b) Flashing speed signs
  - (c) Chicanes at either end of the village
  - (d) Red light cameras at traffic signals
  - (e) A pelican crossing at the traffic signals
  - (f) A mini roundabout at junction of A25 / New Road
  - (g) 20 mph speed limit at the school in Church road
