

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS IN THE DISTRICT OF SEVENOAKS)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND
LOADING & UNLOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING
PLACES) (AMENDMENT 10) ORDER 2009**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the “RTR Act of 1984”), the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as the “TMA 2004”), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (hereinafter referred to as “CEoPC Regulations 2007”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

The following Article 5 (Definitions – General terms) is to be substituted in to “The Kent County Council (Various Roads in the District of Sevenoaks) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009” and in all subsequent amendment Orders:

5. Definitions – General terms

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

“Badges Regulations”	means The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 1991 or 2000 or any re-enactment of the same;
“bus”	has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
“bus stop area”	means the lengths of roads described in Schedules 31 and 32 of Appendices 3 to 31 of this Order and which are intended for the waiting or standing of buses and which are comprised within a road marking complying with diagram nos. 1025.1 or 1025.2 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and which are indicated by a sign complying with diagram nos. 974 or 975 in Schedule 5 to the said Regulations;
“carriageway”	means a way constituting or comprising in a highway being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;
“certificate”	means a certificate or other means of identification of a vehicle which is exempted from restrictions or prohibitions contained in this Order and which has been issued under Section 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
“Civil Enforcement Area”	Means an area where Civil Enforcement of parking restrictions can be carried out, as defined in the TMA 2004.
“Civil Enforcement Officer”	Means a duly appointed officer of the District Council, under the terms of the TMA 2004
“delivering” and “collecting”	in relation to any goods including checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
“disabled person”	has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
“disabled persons vehicle”	has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
“disabled persons badge”	has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 1991 or 2000 or any re-enactment of the same;

“District Council”	Means Sevenoaks District Council.
“driver”	in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;
“dual purpose vehicle”	has the same meaning as in Regulation 3(2) of the Motor Vehicle (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;
“enactment”	means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any Order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;
“goods”	includes postal packages of any description;
“junction”	means the point of intersection of the centre line of the title road named in the Schedule item (unless otherwise stated) with the adjoining kerbline of the road(s) named in the same Schedule item;
“kerbline”	means the edge of carriageway as defined by its boundary with the adjacent footway or verge;
“large goods vehicles”	has the same meaning as a large goods vehicle as prescribed by section 121 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 as amended by the Road Traffic (Driver Licensing and Information Systems) Act 1989
“lay-by”	means any area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and that may be bounded partly by a road marking complying with diagram nos. 1010, 1028.2, 1028.3, 1028.4, 1032 or 1033 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
“legally qualified medical practitioner ”	has the same meaning as in Section 52 of the Medical Act 1956;
“main carriageway”	means any carriageway used primarily by through traffic, (includes carriageway of a slip road) but excludes any lay-by.
“maximum gross vehicle weight”	means the same as “maximum gross weight” as interpreted in the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986 Reg. 3 (2).
“medical practitioners”	means a doctor practising at or visiting a surgery adjacent to that length of road.
“motorcycle” and “invalid carriage”	have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984 and includes any motor vehicle with less than 4 wheels;
“owner”	has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984;
“parking disc”	means a disc issued by a Local Authority, 125mm in diameter coloured blue (or orange up until and including the 31 st March 2003), and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins
“parking place”	means any area of land specified in the Schedules of this Order as “limited waiting”, provided by the Council under Section 32 of the Act of 1984 and the TMA 2004 for use as a parking place;
“parking space”	means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;
“parking waiver”	Means an issued dispensation from the District Council for a specified vehicle to park within a parking place for an agreed period of time, charged in accordance with the tariff of charges.
“pay and display” or “P&D”	means to purchase a P&D ticket from a pay and display machine run by the District Council for payment of parking charges and to display the ticket within the vehicle, with time and date information clearly visible at all times whilst parked.
“pay and display machine” or “P&D machine”	means a P&D ticket issuing machine operated by the District Council
“pay and display ticket” or “P&D ticket”	means a ticket issued from a District Council operated P&D machine, obtained for the purpose of showing proof of payment (according to the published tariffs of charges) for parking, showing the following information; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the time of purchase (ii) the amount paid (iii) the date of purchase (iv) the time of expiry (v) a reference to the issuing machine
“pay by phone”	means a method of payment whereby the charge levied under the District Council’s Tariff of Charges is collected by a District Council appointed third party, via an arranged account, with payment being made over the telephone or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or other means of secure authorised payment.
“permit”	means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 16 of this Order;
“permit holder”	means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 16 of this Order;
“permitted hours”	Means the period of time specified in the relevant schedules of this Order.
“protective cover”	means a protective cover issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 16 of this Order;
“public service	has the same meaning as defined in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

“vehicle”	
“relevant position” means:-	in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that the front part of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front part of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
“resident”	means a person whose usual residence is at premises with a postal address in any street or part of a street described in Schedule 44 to this Order;
“residential business”	means a business the usual place of work which is at a premises with a postal address in any street or a part of a street described in Schedule 44 to this Order;
“School Keep Clear Area”	means the lengths of roads described in Schedule 30, 64 & 72 of Appendices 3 to 31 to this Order which are intended to be kept clear of vehicles and which are comprised within road markings complying with diagram nos. 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and which are indicated by a sign complying with diagram no. 642.2 in Schedule 2 to the said Regulations.
“small goods vehicle”	means a vehicle which does not exceed 3.5 gross metric tonnes;
“small passenger vehicle”	means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;
“solo motorcycle”	means a motorcycle without a side car or trailer attached.
“tariff of charges”	Means the current level of charges agreed by the District Council
“telegraphic line”	has the same meaning as in the Telegraph Act 1878;
“traffic sign”	has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984

** Pedal cycles and motorcycles may be parked without charge, without the need to display a ticket and without time constraint.*

*** ‘Pay by Phone’ transactions attract additional charges to cover the administration of the operator and costs incurred during the transaction process.*

The additional transaction charges should be made public by the operator as part of the transaction process.

Telephony charges incurred in the costs of making the transaction depend on network provider and phone service and are the responsibility of the applicant.

Evidence of the qualification for a ‘Green vehicle’ parking permit must be provided by the applicant and the issue of such a permit is at the discretion of the Council.
