



Looking from North to South




Looking from South to North

Re: Request for traffic calming measures to help solve the problems caused by excessive speed, poor road layout and impaired sight lines on Hosey Hill.

Discussed and agreed by WTC's Highways and Lighting Committee on 25 April 2016 in the following order of priority:

- 1) Lengthen double yellow lines on Hosey Hill. Yellow lines to be extended/joined between Hosey Ridge and Wayside. The point where the fatality on 25 March took place Reason Line of sight is impaired by parked vehicles.
- 2) Move 30mph speed limit back to the top Hosey Hill Car Park. Reason To reduce speed of vehicles coming down Hosey Hill.
- 3) Install 30mph signage at the bottom of Hosey Hill with the junction of High Street, Westerham(A25) currently no speed signage in place.
- 4) Install Flashing speed sign on Hosey Hill, showing vehicle speed. Reason to advise drivers of their speed coming down Hosey Hill.

I hope this is helpful for your presentation at the JTB in May.

Dear All,

As you are all aware there was a fatality on Hosey Hill on Good Friday and another incident the following day.

We need KCC to take action immediately to help solve the problems caused by excessive speed, poor road layout, and dangerous potholes on this road and others in the Parish of Westerham.

What we feel needs to be done is that the double yellow lines on Hosey Hill are extended/joined between Hosey Ridge and Wayside. The point where the fatality took place.

There should be a new 30MPH sign installed at the A25 end of Hosey Hill, there is nothing there at the moment.

The point at which the road speed changes from 60MPH to 30mph should be moved further up the hill, away from the area with houses.

A flashing speed sign should be installed at the top of Hosey Common before the entry to Westerham, this sign should show the speed the traffic is travelling, not just 30mph.

We request that you give these suggestions your immediate attention before anyone else is killed on Hosey Hill.

We have reported this on the KCC CSM database reference 208979 and understand that it will be discussed at the next SDC Joint Transport Board Meeting in May.
