Subject: Repair & Renew Grant 2014

Details of Decision taken: Three applications to the Repair & Renew Grant to receive funding as follows:

96 High Street, Edenbridge £ 5,000.00
100 High Street, Edenbridge - £ 3,750.00
97 Millstone Close, South Darenth - £ 1,300.00

Reason for Decision

- Cabinet, on 8 May 2014 approved the guidelines for the Repair & Renew Grant and delegated authority to the Economic & Community Development Portfolio Holder to agree funding. After DEFRA made changes to the scheme in late May, Cabinet agreed changes to the Guidelines on 5 June 2014.
- Funding that this Council pays out under the Repair & Renew Grant is claimed back quarterly from DEFRA.
- Three applications were received and appraised during October 2014.
- Officers recommended that three applications, from 96 High Street, Edenbridge, 100 High Street, Edenbridge and 97 Millstone Close, South Darenth be awarded a total of £ 10,050.00.
- One application, from Eynsford, was not recommended to receive funding, as the application was for ineligible items.
