BRIEFING: STARTER HOMES INITIATIVE

Government issued a consultation (ended 09/02/15) on 'Stepping onto the Property

Ladder' - a starter homes initiative for first time buyers.

The initiative will help younger people (under 40-years of age) to buy their first home

on new-build developments.

The developments will be targeted on brownfield land not previously allocated for

housing (currently allocated instead for commercial or industrial use) where there are limited remediation and infrastructure costs and the land is no longer

required/not viable for a commercial or industrial use.

The homes will be marketed at a least 20% below the local market value.

Government hopes that 100,000 starter homes will be developed under the initiative

over the next 5-years.

We have fed back on the consultation and suggested the homes should be offered to

the same 'in need' group as that covered under the Help-to-Buy shared-ownership

scheme.

This could potentially provide the means to deliver a 'type' of affordable housing in

lieu of fewer units coming forward as a result of recent changes to the planning

system.
