Details of Decision:

Three applications to the Big Community Fund to receive funding as follows:

Sevenoaks Eastern ward - £ 2,000

Hextable ward - £ 2,000

Westerham & Crockham Hill ward – £ 500

One application, from Sevenoaks Town & St Johns ward will be considered at the February meeting following receipt of further information.

Application forms for Sevenoaks Town & St Johns, Sevenoaks Eastern, Hextable and Westerham & Crockham Hill ward applications.

Reasons for Decision:

It was agreed by Cabinet on 21 July 2011 that £120,000 be allocated to a new grant scheme, entitled the Big Community Fund, from the additional New Homes Bonus Scheme funding. £10,000 would be made available each month for Members to bid for projects to enhance local areas. The fifth round closed on 3 January 2012 and the applications received were appraised on 18 January 2012, using an agreed appraisal template and decision-making form.

Members present recommended that three projects from Sevenoaks Eastern ward, Hextable ward and Westerham & Crockham Hill ward should receive a total of £4,500.

A fourth application, from Sevenoaks Town & St Johns will be considered at the February meeting following receipt of further information.
