LICENSING ACT 2003 – Section 23

Notice of determination for application premises licence

Sevenoaks District Council being the licensing authority, on the 4 August 2009 received an application for a premises licence in respect of premises known as Tesco Stores Ltd, 39-41 High Street, Edenbridge, Kent, TN8 5AD.

On the 22 September 2009, there being valid representations which were received and had not been withdrawn, a hearing was held to consider these representations, and having considered them the Licensing Sub-Committee determined as follows:

To grant the Premises Licence:

Section M: To allow sale of alcohol to be consumed off the premises every day from 06:00 to 23:00 hours

Section O: Hours premises are open to the public every day from 06:00 until 23:00 hours

To add the conditions on the Licence as follows:

Mandatory Conditions:

The supply of alcohol

Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions:-

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

respect of (a) at a time where there is no designated premises supervisor in the premises licence, or

a (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

This licence granted at the Hearing is effective from the 22 September 2009.
