The potential breach of the Code of Conduct was identified as paragraph 3(1):

Paragraph 3(1) – you must treat others with respect.

It was noted that since the Sub-Committee originally referred the matter to the Monitoring Officer on 4 August 2010 there had been conciliation between the subject member and complainant. The subject member had apologised. It was also noted that the complainant had requested a withdrawal of the complaint. As a result of these developments the Monitoring Officer brought the matter back to the Assessment Sub-Committee under s.16 of the Standards Committee (England) Regulations 2008 for reconsideration.

The Sub-Committee agreed to thank the Monitoring Officer for her work to resolve the matter.

Resolved: That the initial decision to investigate be reversed and that no further action be recommended.
