1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest in respect of any matter discussed or voted on at the meeting.

3. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE FROM THE ISTANBUL KEBAB, MIRAC CATERING LIMITED, 42 HIGH STREET, EDENBRIDGE, KENT TN8 5AJ FOR VARIATION UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003

The Hearing gave consideration to a report by the Community and Planning Services Director giving details of an application under the Licensing Act 2003 for variation of the existing Premises Licence at Istanbul Kebab, Mirac Catering Limited, High Street, Edenbridge, Kent. It was noted that objections had been received and that accordingly the application had been referred to the Sub-Committee for determination.

At 10:25 a.m. the Hearing Members withdrew to consider the issues raised.

At 10:40 a.m. the Hearing Members returned to the Council Chamber.

It was unanimously

- (a) Resolved: That a Premises Licence in respect of Istanbul Kebab, Mirac Catering Limited, High Street, Edenbridge, Kent, subject to the conditions contained in the licence attached as an appendix to these minutes, be granted.

Sevenoaks District Council being the licensing authority, on the 15 December 2010 received an application for a variation to a premises licence in respect of premises known as Istanbul Kebab, Mirac Catering Ltd. 42 High Street, Edenbridge, Kent TN8 5AJ.

On the 15 December 2010 there being valid representations which were received and had not been withdrawn, a hearing was held to consider these representations, and having considered them the Licensing Sub-Committee determined as follows:

To grant the variation of the Premises Licence:

Section L: To additionally allow late night refreshment on Saturday morning and Sunday morning from 00:00 hours until 01:00 hours.

Section O: Additional hours premises are open to the public on Saturday morning and Sunday morning from 00:00 hours until 01:00 hours.

The reason for approving the application was that the variation was only minor, with an extra hour on Friday and Saturday nights. The Panel considered the licensing objectives in making their decision.

This licence granted at the Hearing is effective from the 15 December 2010.
