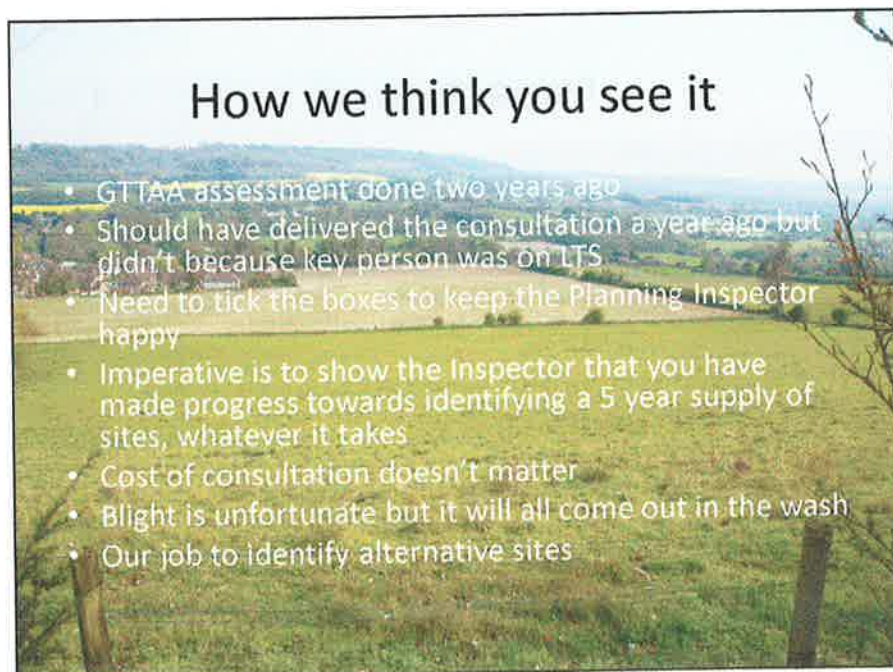


How we see it....
