Reason for Decision (please set out in full)

Over recent months there have been complex negotiations regarding the Supporting People funding for the Home Improvement Agency (HIA) and the contents of the HIA contract for the delivery of Disabled Facilities Grants (DFG's). It has now been clarified that the contract for the HIA no longer includes the delivery of DFG's but that the core funding will provide advice only to DFG applicants. Going forward, the Council will need to negotiate new costs for each stage in the DFG process over and above advice. The HIA have requested additional funds to deliver a service for DFG's over and above advice and across Kent, many Authorities have taken the view that this will not provide the most efficient service and value for money for residents.

There are sufficient skills in house to deliver this service with the potential to generate income in future years.
