To approve Sevenoaks District Council's response to Kent County Council's consultation on the future of Children's Centres' in the Sevenoaks District as appended.

Reason for Decision (please set out in full)

All Members were consulted and given full details of the proposals as they affect the Sevenoaks District. Details of the proposals were also taken to the Sevenoaks District Strategic Board on 11th September 2013, and to Members of the Health Liaison Board on 11th September 2013. Some individual responses were received from Members.

Partners were also consulted. This included the Local Strategic Partnership, the Sevenoaks District Local Children's Trust Board and the Sevenoaks District Health Action Team.

There are currently 7 Children's Centres in the District. The proposals within the consultation that will impact particularly on Children's Centres in the Sevenoaks District include closing Dunton Green Children's Centre and Merry-Go-Round (Westerham) and reducing the number of hours in West Kingsdown from 40 to 18 hours. There will also be additional pressure on Swanley, Sevenoaks and New Ash Green Centres due to an increase in the catchment areas.

The response from Sevenoaks District Council, incorporating the views of the Sevenoaks District Health Action Team is attached as Appendix 1 and will be submitted to Kent County Council by the closing date of 5th October 2013. It should be noted that concerns were noted about the closure of the Merry-Go-Round in Westerham by a representative for Westerham Town Council.

Westerham Town Council have expressed concerns to the District Council about the loss of services in Westerham. The full response from Westerham Town Council is included as Appendix 2 for your information.
