The number of communications with Benefits customers within the partnership continues to grow. There were 167,000 in 2011/12, 212,000 in 2012/13 and already 124,000 in the first six months of 2013/14.

Both partners contributed an additional £100,000 each in 2012/13 which has helped performance improve significantly. The time to process new claims has improved from 59 days in June 2012 to 26 days in August 2013. The need for further funding will be reviewed later in the year.
