Reason for Decision

- Cabinet, on 6 March 2014 approved the guidelines for the Business Flood Support Scheme and delegated authority to the Economic & Community Development Portfolio Holder to agree funding.
- The Council was allocated £172,500 by DEFRA towards the Business Flood Support Scheme
- Three applications were received and appraised on Wednesday 24 September.
- Officers present recommended that the applications received, from Pipers Florist, Trevor Bryant Plumbing and The Bill Skinner Studio Ltd should receive a total of £ 8,002.29.


