There is a slight error on the plan - the proposal is to extend the existing 2pm-3pm yellow line by 2m and to shorten the existing double yellow lines by the same. This allows a car to park on the single yellow line at the end of the double yellows without overhanging or impinging the access to the driveways between no's 65 and 67.
