Potential new parking restictions - Cramptons Road, Sevenoaks

I have just heard from a neighbour that you have circulated letters to residents of Cramptons Road regarding the alteration of the disabled bay at 141 Cramptons Road. I did not receive a letter.

There is already an acute shortage of parking spaces in Cramptons Road, during the day employees from the business's of Godfreys & Haywards Otford Road use the road for parking and when residents return from work at night and at weekends it becomes very difficult to find a space, some people own two/three vehicles.

You therefore see that when the gentlman of Cramptons Road requirs a larger disabled bay it is very upsetting for the residents, the present disabled bay is perfectly adequate for his needs, he only uses a Renault Clio car.
