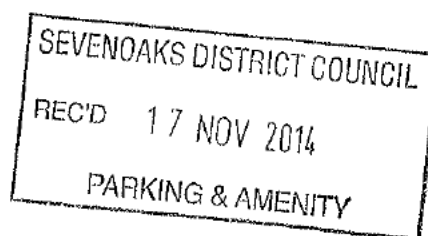

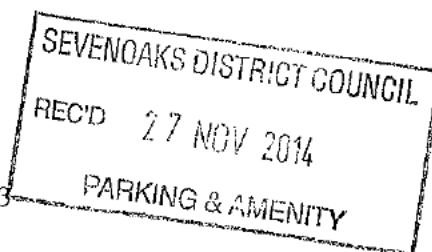

Potential new parking restrictions - Cramptons Road, Sevenoaks

I have just heard from a neighbour that you have circulated letters to residents of Cramptons Road regarding the alteration of the disabled bay at 141 Cramptons Road. I did not receive a letter.

There is already an acute shortage of parking spaces in Cramptons Road, during the day employees from the business's of Godfreys & Haywards Otford Road use the road for parking and when residents return from work at night and at weekends it becomes very difficult to find a space, some people own two/three vehicles.

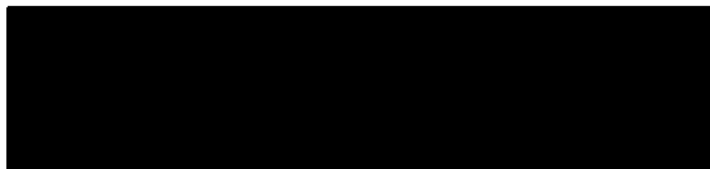
You therefore see that when the gentleman of [REDACTED] Cramptons Road requires a larger disabled bay it is very upsetting for the residents, the present disabled bay is perfectly adequate for his needs, he only uses a Renault Clio car. The majority of the time this vehicle is parked in his garage and the disabled bay remains empty.

This gentleman manages his disability very well, he walks well manages to collect shopping from Sainsburys, gardens and even climbs a stepladder to prune his tree you never see him on crutches/sticks (only when it suits his purpose), he has a wheelchair which you only see when it is serviced.

In my opinion the only reason that the resident of [REDACTED] Cramptons Road requires the extra length disabled bay is purely and only because he is entitled to it, I think there needs to be common sense used here.

I would therefore like to state that I am against the proposal to lengthen the disabled bay at 141 Cramptons Road.

Please, Please can some common sense be used in this decision for once.
