1h Property Searches Briefing - verbal update - Christine Nuttall

The Council along with most other local authorities have outstanding claims in relation to the reimbursement of Local Land Charge Personal Search fees. This came about as a result of the Government deciding that personal search fee information should have been obtainable under the Environment Information Regulations 2004.

Bevan Brittan has been representing all the authorities concerned with authorities contributing to a pooled fund. Initially the claim against our authority was and the final settlement for our authority announced on the 13th June is **authority**. The Government has already awarded each authority a sum of **authority** to partly cover the loss of the search fee income and any claims that may be made. Our authority had anticipated that we would be required to settle the claim and so had set aside the Government receipt and so the impact to this Council will be limited to plus interest and we can meet the shortfall within existing budgets.

Cllr F asked whether this was a group offer or would we be able to go individually with our cheque in settlement and Members asked who we would be required to pay. CN stated that we would be paying the Land Charge companies who had brought the claim against our authority and that those authorities who did not accept their settlement figure would be left to continue the action on their own without any continuing support from Bevan Brittan. Not all authorities had to accept as a group.
