

Collection arrangements - 24th December 2015 to 11th January 2016

Boxing Day (26th December) falls on a Saturday this year. To compensate a public holiday has been declared on Monday 28th December. Refuse collections are difficult to organise especially when there are effectively three holidays around the same weekend. This schedule delays the Friday, 25th December weekly collection by only one day to Saturday 26th December - we have been advised that Dunbriek Transfer Station will be open - resulting in a maximum 9 day emptying interval. Reversion to normal collection days for customers is by 11th January. An unusual Saturday catch up is necessary but there are no missed 'weekly' collections or double waste collections. This option relies on the co-operation of refuse collection colleagues to work on what would be considered a public holiday.
