- For the supply of alcohol, the designated premises supervisor will always be on site.
- All supply of alcohol will be authorized by a person who holds a personal licence.
- All staff will be aware that it is illegal to sell alcohol for lower than the permitted price, in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979.
- The responsible person will ensure that no irresponsible promotion is made, such as drinking within a time limit or drinking as much as possible, no provision of unlimited alcohol for free or at a discount.
- No promotions to sell alcohol through flyers or posters in the vicinity of the premises.
- Staff will be aware that it is totally forbidden to pour alcohol directly in the mouth of customers.
- Water will be available at all times to everyone.
- All waiters and staff will be made aware of "Challenge 25" and ask for ID in case of doubt.

All staff will be trained to ask customers to leave quietly in the evening when necessary. There will be appropriate signage at the premises requesting customers to leave quietly.
