## Portfolio Holder Executive Decision Statement


### The Local Authority (Executive Arrangements)(Meetings and Access to Information)(England) Regulations 2012

<b>Subject</b> Resident Parking Arrangements - Buckhurst 2 Car Park
<b>Details of Decision taken</b> To approve a new facility to accommodate Sevenoaks town residents who have no access to parking in the town, in the new Sevenoaks Town Car Park. Two facilities are proposed, a Resident Season Ticket for £300 pa and a “dusk ‘til dawn” permit valid weekdays from 4pm to 10am and all day Saturday for £50pa. Resident eligibility will be subject to certain criteria and season tickets and permits will be issued at the Council’s sole discretion.
<b>Reason for Decision</b> Many local residents who have no access to on or off street parking in the town have requested parking in the new car park when it reopens in April 2019. The new season ticket and permit arrangements are intended to meet this need.
<b>All Documents considered</b> Not applicable.
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the Member when making the Decision</b> Not Applicable.
<b>Financial implications</b> The provision of a Resident Season Ticket and a “dusk ‘til dawn” season ticket is intended to provide some accommodation for residents of Sevenoaks town who have no parking provision. The

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levels of charge are designed to regulate demand and the impact on income.
