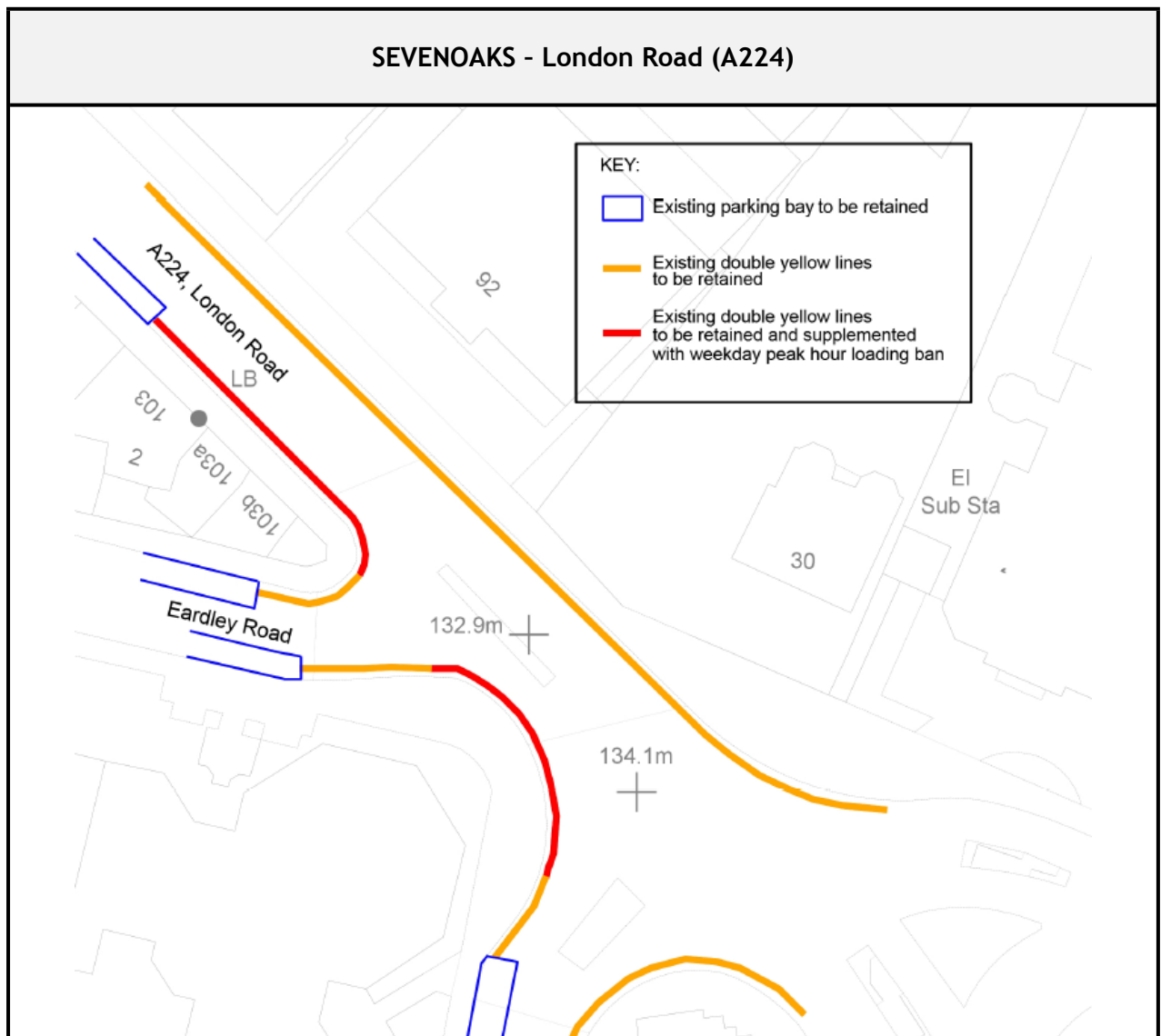

DESCRIPTION	PROPOSED CHANGES
Southwest side, near junctions with Argyle Road and Eardley Road	New loading restriction (no loading, Monday to Friday, 7am - 10am & 4pm - 7pm) to supplement existing double yellow line restrictions

OBJECTION RECEIVED

<b>OFFICERS' COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATION</b>
<p><b>COMMENTS:</b></p> <p>The existing double yellow line parking restrictions at this location are regularly abused, particularly by visitors to local businesses. At peak traffic times on weekdays this has a detrimental effect on the safety and efficient movement of traffic using London Road (A224).</p> <p>Supplementing the parking restrictions with a loading ban during these peak traffic times will improve road safety, reduce congestion, and facilitate enforcement. Alternative parking is available nearby for visitors and for loading/unloading activities.</p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION:</b></p> <p>It is recommended that the objections be set aside, and the proposal be implemented, as drawn.</p>
