2015/16 Corporate & Strategic Priorities

- Set up commercial trading company to enable SDC to invest in property on a commercial basis
- Expand licensing partnership to four partners
- Align role of Chairman with Council's corporate priorities & remodel administrative support
- Continue to maintain successful partnerships & shared services

Example highlights and successes: -

Quercus 7

- Registered with Companies House December 2015
- To allow SDC to invest in residential property on a commercial basis ensuring a sustainable income
- Non-executive Directors
- £5m of £25m approved for the Property Investment Strategy has been earmarked for Quercus 7
- Potential joint ventures with Quercus Housing







Croft Road, Westerham

- Q7 purchased a 3 / 4 bedroom new house in Westerham on 21.1.19 for £500,000
- The property will be rented to the private sector.
- The return we expect is close in excess of 5% over a 10 year average.



Expand Licensing Partnership

- London Borough of Bexley joined Licensing Partnership on 31st October 2016
- The first District Council Licensing Partnership to incorporate the work of a London Borough
- Further savings from 4th partner resulted in service becoming cost neutral for Sevenoaks residents (first time since LA 2003)
- Majority roll out of on-line forms allows residents to access licensing services 24/7

LICENSING PROACTIVE SUCCESSES

- Introduced a partnership wide computerised knowledge test for all new drivers in July 2017 this has substantially raised the professional standards of new drivers, as the new test covers safeguarding, numeracy, road & route knowledge
- Recently the partnership was part of the a successful bid to get government funding to install charging points exclusively for use of taxi vehicles which are Ultra Low Emission Vehicles. Once installed, this should encourage more taxi drivers to change over to ULEV vehicles which will benefit air quality.
- The tri-annual statutory review of Gambling policy was carried out across the partnership in 2018 ensuring policies were in line as much as possible and strengthened where needed
- The partnership supported the delivery of the Metropolitan Police initiative WAVE (Welfare and Vulnerability engagement) throughout 2018 ensuring all licensees were aware of the presentation
- Following concerns raised by residents (and Members) about the use of a particular event site which was increasing in frequency, Licensing intervened with the main event organiser (Neverworld) and as a result of their robust approach, this lead to an agreement that the site would only be used for that one event each year, and not many events.


- Supported around 340 council meetings

Legal services

- Successes have included:-
 - High Court injunction at Combe Bank to prevent any development taking place
 - High profile environmental health prosecution against UK Chicken Doner & Poultry Ltd and Sukru Ahmet which resulted in a 4 months custodial sentence
