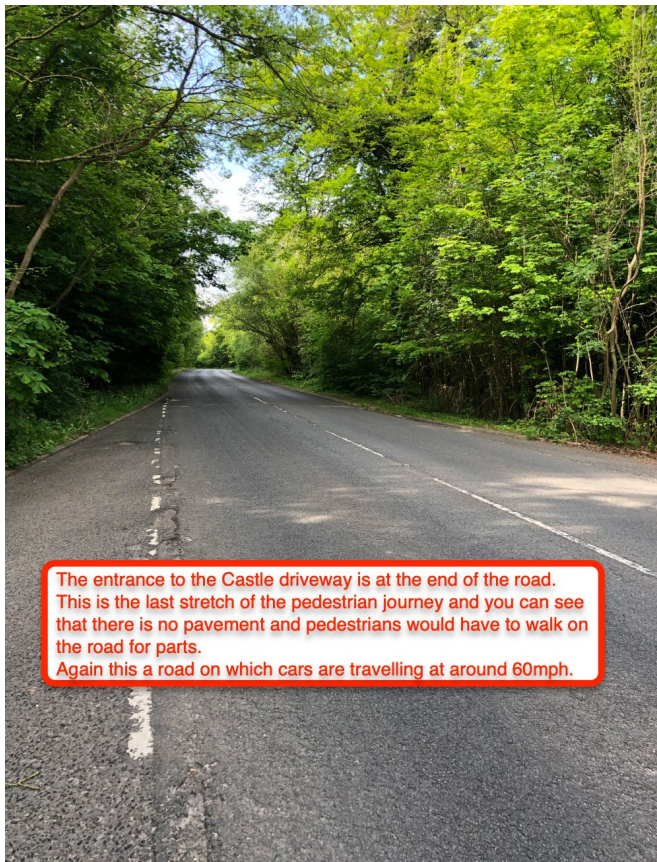






Narrow grass verge which is non-existent in places requiring pedestrians to walk on the road

This is about a third of the distance from the station to the entrance gate and the start of the driveway down to the Castle.
There is no pavement, just a narrow grass verge.
This is a 60mph road with cars travelling regularly at this speed.



The entrance to the Castle driveway is at the end of the road.
This is the last stretch of the pedestrian journey and you can see that there is no pavement and pedestrians would have to walk on the road for parts.
Again this a road on which cars are travelling at around 60mph.
