Introduction and Background

- 1 West Kent CCG, the GP-led organisation who plan and deliver health services across West Kent, have been working to improve health facilities in Edenbridge.
- Following extensive public and partner consultations in 2018, West Kent CCG's Governing Body agreed to progress a new combined surgery and hospital in Edenbridge. This option was supported by GP partners at Edenbridge Medical Practice and Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust (KCHFT), who provide most of the current health services at Edenbridge hospital and to local people in their homes.
- The CCG set up an implementation group to work on progressing this new development including potential sites, planning and finances.
- 4 Members will be updated at the meeting with a presentation on the progress of the new Edenbridge medical facility, by a representative from West Kent CCG.
- The CCG also plan and deliver a range of GP and health services across the central and southern parts of Sevenoaks District, as well as the rest of West

Kent. Members will also receive an update on this work including the operation of the District Nursing Service and relevant updates on other GP services.
