Dear Mr Kirkman

I have received an email from Kent Police, following an incident which took place on the premises of **The Vault**.

I am lead to believe you have separated from [REDACTED] and it may be due to this, that an unfortunate situation occurred (fire). While I am sorry to hear about your personal circumstances, the purpose of this email is not to discuss your personal life but speak about the Premises Licence which was awarded to you. I understand the incident was controlled and you have had a visit from Kent Police. Kent Police had some concerns with the general running of the premises (they will likely discuss those concerns directly with you) and their CCTV body cams revealed evidence of tables and chairs in the garden area and people taking drinks outside.

As advised at our previous meeting, as the Licence Holder you are ultimately responsible for the business and running it in line with the conditions. Section 19 of your Premises Licence states "*Customers temporarily leaving the premises e.g. to smoke ,shall not be permitted to take drinks or open glass containers with them.*" The images provided by Kent Police can be used as evidence to prove this.
