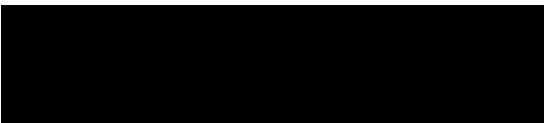

Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

The supply of alcohol

Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions:-

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- (a) at a time where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 4 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

Disposal of waste bottles into external receptacles where the noise will be audible to neighbouring properties must not occur between 22:00 and 07:00 hours.

Prominent, clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

Performers should be supervised to ensure the loading of equipment at the end of any event does not disturb surrounding residents.

Live music should be limited to once in any 7 day period.

Recorded music should be limited to once in any 7 day period.

The licensee or a nominated representative shall provide current telephone contact number to neighbouring residents and shall receive and respond to complaints throughout the duration of all noisy events. If there is not a satisfactory response then the resident should contact Environmental Protection.

No amplified or live music sound should give rise to a nuisance to neighbouring residents.
