We are the nearest neighbour to the premises, unconnected to Bore Place. The

applicant has not communicated with us at all although we have talked to his

landlord at Bore Place who knew nothing about the application.

The premises for the application are situated in an active farmyard, up a long driveway, approached from a lane.

The granting of this licence will undermine the promotion of the "prevention of crime and disorder" because the sale of alcohol and consumption outside the premises in such an environment will increase the opportunity for crime owing to the close proximity of farm machinery and contents of barns.
- safety" enabling the consumption of alcohol outside the premises but in an area very close to livestock and dangerous farm machinery.
- 3. The granting of this licence will undermine the promotion of "protection

of children from harm" and is totally incompatible with the published plans for Bore Place. Their focus is towards opportunities for children and

young people of all abilities through the provision of more programmes of work to be undertaken by daily visits or by school residential visits enabled by the recent increase in accommodation. A licence to sell alcohol here seems totally inappropriate.
