

## APPENDIX H

Chiddingstone Parish Council has no objection to the sale of alcohol as part of this premises licence application. The Parish Council is concerned about the potential impact, disturbance and public nuisance to local residents if amplified live and recorded music is provided, but appreciate that this is deregulated if there is an licence to sell alcohol.

The Parish Council would welcome conditions attached to this licence to limit public nuisance, if it is possible to restrict the numbers attending an event selling alcohol (separate to the cross-country events held at this site) to perhaps 50 and to restrict the number of vehicles/trailers selling alcohol to 1. A further condition limiting the times that amplified live and recorded music is provided would also be welcome.
