Dear Sirs

I write in support of the recent CIL application made by Eynsford Parish Council in respect of Eynsford Village Hall.

The hall was constructed in 1908 and has served the community of Eynsford and surrounding areas well since that time. There are over 800 lets a year from infants to the elderly, and is used for a variety of purposes ranging from educational to exercise for all.

The hall however is suffering from serious structural problems and its life is limited. Surveys reveal that the cost of restoration is unviable and there would still remain significant defects such as poor energy efficiency and lack of parking. It is also located in the middle of a residential area, and brings significant noise and nuisance to neighbours when events are held.

As you will be aware, planning consent has been granted for a new hall to be constructed on Harrow Meadow which will have significant advantages to the community and to the environment. It is located away from residential properties, is energy efficient and has a large car park. It cannot be emphasised enough how much of a benefit a new hall will bring to the residents of Eynsford and the wider community as hirers also come from the surrounding areas.

The old hall is coming to the end of its natural life and if it were to close with no alternative venue being in place, it will be a significant loss to the community as it is the social hub of the village and there are no comparable spaces available to hire locally.

I would therefore like to support the CIL application and hope that the Council will recognise what a vital service a hall in Eynsford provides.


I am writing to voice my total support for the current application for CIL funding lodged by Eynsford Parish Council towards the rebuild of our new Village Hall.
