Introduction and Background

- 1 At Annual Council the Council's Policy Framework, as set out in Appendix F of the Council's constitution is agreed.
- 2 Each year a review takes place for any policies and strategies to ensure we are complying with legislation and other guidance.
- Following the annual review, it came to light that a further change may be required to bring the current practice in line.
- The change requested was that the Community Safety Strategy and action plan be removed from the Framework, and be treated as a key decision in the same way that the Community Plan was for consistency.
- As the Community Safety Strategy and Action plan is a Statutory Policy under the Council's Policy Framework, it must be adopted by Full Council as we have a statutory duty to provide a Community Safety Strategy as set out within the Crime and Disorder Act 1998, and therefore it is unable to be adopted by Cabinet.
