Subject: Rescission of DIYSO refund monies previously approved under Decision 03 (2023/24) to allocate £101,540 DIYSO refund monies to fund the full time post of Senior Private Sector Housing Officer for a fixed term period of 22 months.

Details of Decision To agree the rescission of DIYSO refund monies previously approved under Decision 03 (2023/24).

Reason for Decision

In 2012 following Portfolio Holder approval S106 affordable housing monies were used to fund a "Do It Yourself Shared Ownership Scheme" (DIYSO), in partnership with Moat Housing. In total, 19 families were assisted into low cost home ownership under the scheme.

DIYSO purchasers are able to "staircase" (increase) their level of ownership. At each point of staircasing, monies originally contributed are refunded to the District Council and are ringfenced for onward use as set out in the Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document 2011 (SPD).

In March of this year approval was given in Portfolio Holder Decision 03 (2023/24) to allocate £101,540 DIYSO refund monies to fund the full time post of Senior Private Sector Housing Officer for a fixed term period of 22 months.

Following a review of the structure and budget within the Private Sector Housing Team funds have been identified for the post of Senior Private Sector Housing Officer.

The DIYSO funds are therefore no longer required to fund the post of Senior Private Sector Housing Officer and approval is sought to rescind said monies.
