Subject: Environmental Health Out of Hours Service

Details of Decision taken: To stop the reactive out of hours service undertaken by the Environmental Health Team on Friday and Saturday Evenings between 18:00 and 00:00.

Reason for Decision

A Service Change Impact Assessment was agreed at Cabinet in February 2023 for the removal of the reactionary Environmental Health Out of Hours Service (Friday and Saturday Evenings 18:00 to 00:00) resulting in a budgetary saving of approximately £15,000 per year. Whilst this SCIA was agreed, the Council Leader at that time requested that the service continue until such time as consideration could be given to other options.

Demand for the Out of Hours Service has reduced significantly over the past few years. This reduction in calls has in part occurred from a change in the contractor terms within our stray dog kennelling contract and as a result of the NoiseApp being introduced.

The majority of calls that are received by the OOH service are 1st time complaints and are dealt with through the provision of information (this could reasonably be done during the normal working week) or regarding irregular or one-off incidents that are unlikely to constitute an actionable problem.

Since April 2022, the Environmental Health Out of Hours Service has received 113 calls (only 25 since April 2023). Of these, only around 8 required visits to be undertaken (2 in 2023) and none resulted in legal action being taken by the duty officer. During this period the service has cost approximately £21,000 or £185 per call (£255 since April 23) This does not represent value for customers or the District Council.
