Recommendation to Annual Council:

To note the delegations of executive functions and appointments to the Cabinet made by the Leader.

Introduction

- 1 The Executive carry out the functions that are not the responsibility of Full Council.
- 2 Cabinet Members are appointed annually by the Leader and would normally hold office until the next Annual meeting of the Council when they may be re-appointed.
- 3 Political balance requirements of Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 do not apply to the composition of the Executive.
- 4 The Leader recommends for adoption at the Annual meeting of Council a Scheme of Delegation (as set out in Appendix U.)
- 5 The appointments to Cabinet made by the Leader and their areas of responsibility are set out in Appendix R, Annex 1 (of the Constitution.) The Cabinet will consist of the Leader of the Council and six Portfolio Holders.
