Committee members and senior club members are present whenever the club is open. They will ensure that the four licensing objectives are implemented. We have monthly committee meetings where the objectives can be discussed and modified where necessary.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We currently have external CCTV. We will be installing internal CCTV shortly.
Photo ID will be requested from anyone who appears to be underage.
Plastic cups will be mandatory for anyone drinking outside of the clubhouse.
Anyone appearing to be intoxicated will be refused drinks.

c) Public safety

Fire extinguishers are provided and will be checked annually. Ditto smoke detectors. Electrical equipment will be PAT tested annually.
CCTV will be provided as above.
Clear access will be maintained for ambulance access (necessary for our rugby matches already)

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We are sufficiently remote to not cause a public nuisance – the nearest property is over 100m away.
CCTV will be provided as above.

e) The protection of children from harm

Several members of our committee and club have child safeguarding certificates and are DBS checked. We have several first aiders. (these are RFU requirements). Any child attending our club will need to be supervised by an adult.
