The Kent County Council (Various Roads in the District of Sevenoaks) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and On Street Parking Places (Amendment 22) Order 2009

Dear Mr Bracey

Thank you for your letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011 and enclosed drawing concerning the above subject.

Kent Police have no specific observations to make regarding this proposal, however in general terms we would expect the following:

- The application meets the necessary criteria.
- The introduction of prohibition of waiting complies in all respect with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- If being used for 'corner protection' the prohibition of waiting restriction is for a 24-hour period and extends for a distance of at least 10 metres from any junction. Thus preventing vehicles mistakenly parking during the hours of darkness and contravening provisions of the Roads Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1994.
- The introduction of such measures will not leave the Police with the task of carrying out constant enforcement issues such as obstruction by transferring the problem to other areas.
- The safety of other road users is not compromised by the introduction of these measures.

Civil Parking Enforcement will require your Authority to ensure resources are available to enforce this proposal.

Dear Mr Bracey

With reference to the above, and in response to your letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011, please find enclosed my completed consultation response. May I say how grateful I am for the Council's positive response to the request to extend the originally proposed parking restrictions in Otford to include Bubblestone Road, The Butts and The Old Walk and to prevent dangerous parking on corners.

Relative to dangerous parking, may I make a request for an additional short stretch of double yellow lines on the opposite side of Bubblestone Road facing the exit from The Butts in the area marked on the attached map.

- Cars frequently park in the area marked and will still be able to do so outside 9am to 10 am.
- Cars coming up Bubblestone whether to turn into The Butts or to go straight on are forced onto the wrong side of the road when approaching The Butts.
- Cars coming out of The Butts on the correct side of the road frequently meet these
  oncoming cars face to face involving some very sharp breaking.
- This situation is exacerbated by the very restricted view around the corner of The Butts and Bubblestone due to heavy foliage where marked.

Although there have been no accidents so far as I know, 20 metres or so of additional yellow lines would make this quite heavily used junction much safer; it is also regularly used for cars who have parked facing up Bubblestone to reverse and go back to the main road.





I have only just been shown a copy of your letter dated 8 June regarding the proposed restrictions on parking in Bubblestone Road. I am commenting on these in my capacity as Land lord of I strongly object to the proposals.

The use of travel by train is to be encouraged. As more and more people need to drive to the station surely the Council should be having a dialogue with the Rail companies to provide more facilities at affordable prices before restricting parking in adjacent roads.

Clearly any restrictions on parking on roads being used by commuters using the station will simply have a knock on effect on other roads currently not being used for this purpose.

In the case of your proposals for Bubblestone Road there will be a severe knock on impact on the shops in the Parade and the residents above. For the most part staff in these shops and the residents in the flats above do not have anywhere to park and for years have used Bubblestone Road from the entrance to the shops up to the rear access way to park. This has not caused any inconvenience to the residents in Bubblestone Road who as you say all have off street parking available.. If this "facility" is not available where do these people park. The need to move a vehicle at some point during the day is of no use to residents out at work all day or say hairdressers who cannot stop part way through a hairdressing appointment while they move their car. Similarly some of the shops only have one employee and to move their vehicle would require shutting the shop.

If parking is restricted it is highly likely that commuters will use the parking outside the shops. This is shown incorrectly on the plan as "Private forecourt" but is in fact Council owned parking beyond the demarcation studs. Commuter parking in this area will have a disastrous effect on the viability of the shops and shopping in Otford. These shops have survived the onslaught of the out of town shopping facilities elsewhere in Sevenoaks to a great extent because of the parking facilities immediately adjacent to the shops. If this is blocked by the users of the station, most shoppers will no longer be able to access the shops.

These significant disadvantages of the proposals far outweigh the perceived benefits of solving a problem which may or may not arise..

If it is decided to proceed with the proposals, some form of 'residents' parking permits for the shopkeeper/residents will be required to ease their difficulties and support the shops but the problem of commuter parking in the forecourt remains.
